
Tool	Description	Photo
You will need the following tools:		
10mm Socket	Disconnect the negative post on the 12V battery under the hood	
Hands	Fold the second row seats forward	

Trim Tool	Pop off the left and right trim pieces	
	Remove the piece covering the hybrid battery	
	Remove the orange main disconnect plug on the passenger side of the hybrid battery. Pull up and fold outward.	






Remove the two 10mm bolts securing the HV leads to the battery, and the one 10mm grounding bolt.



Pull out the vent hose




Remove duct for the cooling fan.



Disconnect black wire harness by pulling upwards and folding back.



Pry the gray connector off the metal post.



Remove one 13mm bolt and two 13mm nuts on the back side of the battery.



Remove two 18mm nuts on the front side of the battery.



Pick up the battery with one person on each end and remove from vehicle.



Follow these same steps in reverse to install the replacement battery from Best Hybrid Batteries
